

### **BRANCH OFFICES:**

The Branch Offices are at 140 (Old No.134-A), Arcot Road, Virugambakkam, Chennai-92 and at No.4 (Old No.2/37), Dr. J. Jayalalitha Nagar, Mogappair East, Chennai-37, have registered a steady progress, catering to the members of the respective locality.

# Report on the Audit of the Standalone Financial Statements Opinion

We have audited the standalone financial statements of THE KILPAUK BENEFIT SASWATHA NIDHI LIMITED (CIN: U65991TN1975PLC006842), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 2022, Statement of Profit and Loss, Cash Flow Statement and Notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid standalone financial statements give the information required by the companies Act, 2013 in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Company as at 31st March, 2022 and Profit and its Cash Flows for the year ended on that date.

### **Basis for Opinion**

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013. Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report.

### 1. Statement of Significant Accounting Policies.

- a. Fixed Assets are stated at cost under Gross Block and depreciated as per the provisions of Companies Act 2013.
- b. Depreciation on Assets have been provided as per Schedule II of the Companies Act,2013 based on the useful life of the asset on pro-rata basis with reference to the date of acquisition of the Assets.
- c. Gratuity Benefits: -
  - Gratuity Benefits to employees is funded with LIC of India for all employees. 
